#### Selecting Colleges for Admission

A time-honored principle in applying to schools:

• Reach-These schools are considered harder to get into, with an average admission chance of less than 25%.

 Range-These schools are considered to be in the middle range of a student's admissions goals, with a good chance of admission.

• <u>Safety-</u>These schools are considered to be the most likely to admit a student, with an admission chance of 90% or higher.
