- Subjunctive: Hopes, fears, or commands
- Future: What will happen

Review and demonstrate your ability to use at least 2 for each of the following grammar concepts:

- **Past tenses** (pretérito and imperfecto) (ex: *estaba in casa cuando me llamaron del cine*)
- **Future tense** (ex: *viajaré*, *iré*, *harás*)
- **Subjunctive mood** (ex: espero que, ojalá que, quiero que)

Assignment # 2

Instagram Story – "La vida de otro"

Objective: Use past subjunctive, and conditional tenses in a creative and original fashion.

Assignment Overview:

Create a fake Instagram Story for a fictional, famous, or historical character. Your "story" should be 6–8 slides long, with each slide featuring:

- A caption in Spanish using at least 2 examples of Past subjunctive and Conditional tense
